AN ORDINANCE to amend the Agricultural Bank  
Ordinance.

[8th November, 1928.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Agricultural Bank Short title.  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1929, and shall be read as one Construction.  
with the Agricultural Bank Ordinance, hereinafter called Cap. 132.  
the Principal Ordinance.

Re-enactment  
of s. 10 of  
Cap. 132.

2. The following section shall be inserted as section 10c of the Principal Ordinance :—

Consent by  
trustee to  
temporary  
advance.

10c. The consent by a trustee to the postponement of his security to enable an advance under section 9 hereof to be made shall not of itself be deemed improper or a breach of trust so as to render such trustee liable in respect of any loss or consequences resulting from such advance having been made, any rule of law or equity to the contrary notwithstanding.

Commence-  
ment.

3. This Ordinance shall operate retrospectively and shall be deemed to have commenced and come into operation on the eighth day of November, 1928.
