AN ACT to prescribe certain matters with respect to the
holding of an election for President.

[Assented to 3rd December, 1976]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as **Enactment**
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the **Presidential Elections** Short title
(Prescribed Matters) Act, 1976.

2. The date of every election under section 26 of the Constitution of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago shall be announced not less than twenty-one days nor more than thirty days in advance.
