AN ORDINANCE to correct certain errors in the First Schedule to the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance.

[1st January, 1923.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1926. Short title.

2. The eighth section of Table I of the First Schedule to the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Ordinance (which relates to the case of officers who will be aged 62 next birthday) is hereby amended by the deletion of the figures "5·80" in the eighth line of the third column (which column is headed "20") and the substitution therefor of the figures "4·80." Amendment of s. 8 of Table I of Schedule I of Cap. 84.

3. The eleventh section of Table I of the First Schedule to the said Ordinance (which relates to the case of officers who will be aged 65 next birthday) is hereby amended as follows :—

- (1) in the eighteenth line of the sixth column (which column is headed "35") the figures "2·84" shall be substituted for the figures "3·84."
- (2) in the thirty-first line of the last column (which column is headed "65") the figures "1·85" shall be substituted for the figures "1·83."

4. This Ordinance shall operate retrospectively and shall be deemed to have commenced and come into operation on the first day of January, 1923.
