AN ORDINANCE to amend the Savings Bank Ordinance.

[6th November, 1926.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Savings Bank Short title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1926.

2. Section 11 of the Savings Bank Ordinance is Repeal of s. 11 of Cap. 109. hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following :—

11. The receipt of the manager, trustee, treasurer, Receipts of officers of certain societies. or other officer for the time being of any Penny Savings Bank, charitable or provident institution or society, or of any Friendly Society legally enrolled and certified in the

manner required by the Friendly Societies Ordinance, for any money paid according to the requisition of such manager, trustee, treasurer, or other officer apparently authorised to require such payment, shall be a sufficient discharge for the same.

Repeal of
ss. 28 and 29 of
Cap. 109.

3. Sections 28 and 29 of the Savings Bank Ordinance are hereby repealed, but section 29 shall continue to apply to cases where the amount standing to the credit of a depositor was transferred to the profit and loss account of the bank before the commencement of this Ordinance.
