AN ORDINANCE to amend the Summary Ejectment Ordinance, No. 6.

[24th May, 1893.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Summary Ejectment (Amendment) Ordinance, 1925, and shall be read as one with the Summary Ejectment Ordinance, No. 6, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance. Short title. Construction.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting the words "and includes chattel or moveable houses" after the word "hereditaments." Amendment of s. 2 of Ord. 6.

3. This Ordinance shall operate retrospectively and shall be deemed to have commenced and come into operation on the twenty-fourth day of May, 1893. Ordinance retrospective.
