AN ORDINANCE to amend the Spirits and Spirit
Compounds Ordinance, No. 176.

[24th November, 1922.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Spirits and Spirit Short title.
Compounds (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1922, and Construction.
shall be read as one with the Spirits and Spirit Compounds
Ordinance, No. 176, hereinafter called the Principal
Ordinance.

2. Section 90 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby Duty on
amended by substituting the word "twelve" for the word Spirits.
"eleven" in the sixth line.

3. The Ordinance No. 61 of 1921 is hereby repealed. Repeal.
