AN ORDINANCE to amend the Trustee Ordinance,  
No. 91.

[23rd September, 1922.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Trustee (Amendment) Ordinance, 1922, and shall be read as one with the Trustee Ordinance, No. 91, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance. Short title.  
Construction.

2. The following section shall be read as section 20A of the Principal Ordinance:—

20A. Where the High Court in England or Ireland has made a vesting order under the Trustee Act, 1893, as amended by the Trustee Act, 1893, Amendment Act, 1894, in respect of land or personal estate in the Colony, and the vesting Registration

order so made is produced to the Registrar-General for registration, such vesting order shall on payment of a fee of one pound be registered in the office of the Registrar-General.

For the purposes of this section a duplicate of any vesting order sealed with the seal of the Court making the same or a copy thereof certified as correct by the Officer having the custody of the original order shall have the same effect as the original.
