AN ORDINANCE to amend the Summary Convictions (Offences) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1916, with respect to Prædial Larceny.

[27th November, 1919.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Summary Convictions (Offences) Ordinance, 1919. Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in section eight of the Summary Convictions (Offences) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1916 (which permits persons convicted of certain offences with regard to growing crops in proclaimed districts to be sentenced to corporal punishment), a proclamation under sub-section (3) of that section extending the definition of "growing crops," or under sub-section (4) of that section declaring a district to be a

proclaimed district, whether made before or after the commencement of this Ordinance, may be varied from time to time or revoked by a proclamation made in like manner.
