AN ORDINANCE to amend the Alien Enemies (Amendment) Ordinance, 1917.

*[9th July, 1918.]*

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short Title.      1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Alien Enemies (Amendment) Ordinance, 1918.

Amendment of Section 6 of Ordinance 16—1917.      2. Section 6 of the Alien Enemies (Amendment) Ordinance, 1917, is amended as follows:—

In Sub-section (2) in lieu of the words "After the expiration of the six months from the date of such notice or within such extended time as aforesaid the Court shall if any claim has been sent in under the preceding sub-section" shall be read the words:

“As soon as conveniently may be after the receipt of such notice the Court shall”.

In Sub-section (3) (a) the words “After the expiration of the said six months or such extended time as aforesaid or” shall be omitted.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Alien Enemies (Amendment) Ordinance, 1917, it shall be lawful for the Liquidating Committee at any time to pay and satisfy out of such funds as they may consider to be properly applicable to such purpose any claim which they may deem to be fair and reasonable and which it would have been competent for the claimant to make under Sub-section (1) of Section 6 of the said Ordinance, and also to pay the costs and expenses properly chargeable in connection therewith.
