AN ORDINANCE for the incorporation of certain persons as Trustees of the Royal Prince of Wales Lodge of Freemasons in Trinidad.

[22nd May, 1917.]

WHEREAS Arthur John Hamlyn, Worshipful Master of the Royal Prince of Wales Lodge of Freemasons in Trinidad, John Pendrich, Senior Warden and James Forbes, Junior Warden of the said Lodge are desirous of being formed into a corporate body ;

An whereas it is expedient that the said Arthur John Hamlyn, John Pendrich and James Forbes should be incorporated ;

Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Royal Prince of Short Title.

2. Arthur John Hamlyn and his successors in office as Worshipful Master of the Royal Prince of Wales Lodge of Freemasons in Trinidad, John Pendrich, Senior Warden of the said Lodge and James Forbes, Junior Warden of the said Lodge, and their successors in office as Senior Warden and Junior Warden of the said Lodge respectively shall be and are hereby created a body corporate by the name of "The Incorporated Trustees of the Royal Prince of Wales Lodge of Freemasons in Trinidad," and by that name shall have perpetual succession and shall and may sue and be sued in all Courts of Justice in the Colony, and shall have and use a common seal, which may from time to time be changed.

Provided that no such change shall be made except by a resolution of the members in open lodge assembled.

Passed in Council this Eleventh day of May, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventeen.
