AN ORDINANCE to amend the Diseases of Animals
Ordinance, Ch. 25. No. 2.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Diseases of Animals
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1948, and shall be read as one with
Ch. 25. No. 2. the Diseases of Animals Ordinance.

2. Section 2 of the Diseases of Animals Ordinance is hereby amended by—

Section 2 of
Ch. 25, No. 2
amended

- (a) inserting in the definition of "cattle", immediately after the word "calves" which appears therein, the words "and the water buffalo";
- (b) substituting, in the definition of "disease", for the words "splenic fever" the words "bovine piroplasmosis (splenic fever)".
