AN ORDINANCE to amend the Landlord and Tenant Ordinance, Ch. 27. No. 16.

[5th May, 1949.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Landlord and Tenant (Amendment) Ordinance, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Landlord and Tenant Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short title. Ch. 27. No. 16.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for the words "if any such" the words "such sum as the Magistrate of the district where the distress shall have been made may consider to have been reasonably incurred for expenses of advertisement of sale"; and by deleting the figures appearing opposite the said words.
