AN ORDINANCE to validate certain Bye-Laws made by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of San Fernando.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the San Fernando Slaughter Houses Bye-Laws (Validation) Ordinance, 1949. Short title.

The Bye-Laws with respect to Slaughter Houses made by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of San Fernando under section 160 of the Public Health Ordinance and section 211 of the San Fernando Corporation Ordinance on the 9th day of September, in the year 1943, shall not be deemed to be invalid by reason only of the fact that the approval thereof by the Central Board of Health was not obtained.
