AN ORDINANCE to amend the Affiliation Ordinance, Ch. 5.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Affiliation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Affiliation Ordinance as amended by the Affiliation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1942, which Ordinance as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and shall come into force on such date as the Governor may by proclamation appoint.

2. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the words "of such a sum of money weekly as he may consider reasonable" for the words "of a sum of money weekly not exceeding two dollars a week".

3. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the word "sixteen" for the word "thirteen", and by deleting the proviso to the section.
