AN ORDINANCE to amend the Affiliation Ordinance, Ch. 5. No. 14.

Commencement.

Enactment.

[On Proclamation.]

NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title. Commence-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Affiliation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1946, and shall be read as one with Ch. 5. No. 14, the Affiliation Ordinance as amended by the Affiliation No. 26 of 1942. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1942, which Ordinance as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and shall come into force on such date as the Governor may by proclamation appoint.

- 2. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is Section 5 (1) of hereby amended by substituting the words "of such a sum Ordinance of money weekly as he may consider reasonable" for the words amended. "of a sum of money weekly not exceeding two dollars a week".
- 3. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended Section 6 of by substituting the word "sixteen" for the word "thirteen", Ordinance and by deleting the proviso to the section.
