AN ORDINANCE to validate the nomination and election of certain persons to the Legislative Council and to Municipal and County Councils and to indemnify them from any penal consequences which they may have incurred by sitting and voting as members of such Councils.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Nomination and Election (Validation and Indemnity) Ordinance, 1947. Short title.

2. Any Chairman or member of a Rent Assessment Board appointed thereto under section 5 of the Rent Restriction Ordinance, 1941, as amended from time to time, or of an Agricultural Rent Board appointed thereto under section 3 of the Rents of Small Agricultural Holdings Ordinance, 1943, hitherto nominated or elected as a member of the Legislative Council or as a member of a Municipal or County Council shall be deemed not to have been incapable of being so nominated or elected or to have been or to be incapable of sitting or voting as a member of the Legislative Council or of a Municipal or County Council by reason only of having held before the commencement of this Ordinance the office of Chairman or member of any such Board; and all such persons shall be and are hereby discharged, freed and indemnified from all penal consequences whatsoever incurred by them respectively by sitting or voting as members of the Legislative Council or of any Municipal or County Council while holding any such office prior to the commencement of this Ordinance.

Passed in Council this thirty-first day of January, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven.
