AN ORDINANCE to amend the Arima Corporation
Ordinance, 1938.

[31st December, 1940.]

Commencement.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Arima Corporation Short title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1940, and shall be read as one Construction.
with the Arima Corporation Ordinance, 1938, hereinafter
referred to as the Principal Ordinance. No. 11-1938.

Section 114 (1)
of Principal
Ordinance
amended.

2. Sub-section (1) of section 114 of the Principal Ordinance is amended :—

(a) by deleting the word “and” at the end of paragraph (j) thereof ;

(b) by repealing paragraph (k) thereof and replacing the same by the following :—

(k) the expenses generally of and incidental to the carrying out of the provisions of this Ordinance and of all works and matters incidental thereto, and the expenses generally of and incidental to the carrying out of the provisions of the Public Health Ordinance, or any other Ordinance, imposing duties on the Corporation entailing expenditure ; and

(c) by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph as follows :—

(1) any other sums which have been specifically voted by the Council and the payment of which is approved by resolution of the Legislative Council.

Passed in Council this twentieth day of December, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty.
