[On Proclamation.]

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Importation of Textiles
(Quotas) Ordinance, 1934 (No. 20 of 1934).

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Importation of
Textiles (Quotas) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1937, and shall
commence on a day to be fixed by the Governor by
Proclamation.

Definition of
"Regulated
textiles"
amended.

2. Section 2 of the Importation of Textiles (Quotas)
Ordinance, 1934, is hereby amended by adding to the
definition of "Regulated textiles" the following proviso:—

Provided that for the purposes of this Ordinance any
textile goods of a class in respect of which a
quota has been fixed shall be deemed to be
manufactured in a foreign country unless
accompanied by a certificate of British origin in
the manner and form prescribed.

Passed in Council this twenty-third day of April,
in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and
thirty-seven.
