AN ORDINANCE to amend the Port-of-Spain Corporation  
Ordinance, Cap. 224.

[22nd November, 1932.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Port-of-Spain Short title.  
Corporation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1932, and shall be  
construed as one with the Port-of-Spain Corporation Construction.  
Ordinance, Cap. 224, hereinafter referred to as the  
Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 13 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby  
amended by deleting paragraph (e) of sub-section (4) and  
substituting therefor the following:—

(e) if he has been convicted of treason or felony or Amendment  
of sec. 13 (4) of  
Cap. 224.  
if within the previous ten years he has been  
convicted of any offence involving dishonesty.
