NOTICE is hereby given that Unicell Paper Mills Caribbean Limited is desirous of executing a new project involving the establishment of a Paper Mill and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001 thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the comments of the public are hereby invited on the Environmental Impact Assessment Report.

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.
