NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT PREPARED BY PLANNING ADVISORY AND CONSULTING SERVICES LIMITED; ENGINEERING CONSULTANTS; GEOLOGIST/MINING CONSULTANTS; LAND SURVEYORS—ALI, DEONANAN AND ASSOCIATES LIMITED AND ECOENGINEERING

NOTICE is hereby given that Hermitage Limestone Limited is desirous of executing a new project involving the Establishment of a Quarry Site and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the comments of the public are hereby invited on the Environmental Impact Assessment Report.

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matters under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

The Authority will receive public comments on the Environmental Impact Assessment Report from Wednesday 10th July, 2002 to Friday 9th August, 2002.
