ON BEHALF OF THE TRINCAN OIL LIMITED

NOTICE is hereby given that Trincan Oil Limited is desirous of executing a new project involving the Exploratory Drilling and Expansion, Modification and Maintenance of Existing Production Wells at the Morne Diablo Farmout Block at Quinam-Morne Diablo Oil Fields of Siparia, South Trinidad and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purpose of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Mondays to Fridays from September 2, 2002 to October 11, 2002:

And take notice that the comments of the public are hereby invited on the application for the Certificate and the Environmental Impact Assessment and that a person wishing to submit comments must do so in writing addressed to the Corporate Secretary, Environmental Management Authority, 8, Elizabeth Street, St. Clair, Port-of-Spain from Monday 2nd September, 2002 to Friday 11th October, 2002.
