Act No. 1 of 1990

AN ACT to provide for the Service of Trinidad and
Tobago for the year ending on the 31st day of
December, 1990.

[Assented to 12th December, 1990]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, Short title
1990.

Issue of
\$6,725,755,737 from
Consolidated Fund
authorised

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of six thousand, seven hundred and twenty-five million, seven hundred and fifty-five thousand, seven hundred and thirty-seven dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1990 under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite to a Head is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of six thousand, seven hundred and twenty-five million, seven hundred and fifty-five thousand, seven hundred and thirty-seven dollars for the purpose specified in relation to that Head in the Estimates for the said year.

Commencement

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 1990.
