REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 33 of 1988

[L.S.]

AN ACT to provide for the Service of Trinidad and Tobago for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1989.

*[Assented to 31st December, 1988]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as **Enactment** follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1989. **Short title**

Issue of  
\$6,317,607,556  
from Consolidated  
Fund authorised

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of six thousand, three hundred and seventeen million, six hundred and seven thousand, five hundred and fifty-six dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1989 under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite to a Head is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of six thousand, three hundred and seventeen million, six hundred and seven thousand, five hundred and fifty-six dollars for the purposes specified in relation to that Head in the Estimates for the said year.

Commencement

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 1989.
