REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

**Act No. 11 of 1989**

[L.S.]

AN ACT to vary the appropriation of the sum the issue of  
which was authorised by the Appropriation Act, 1988.

*[Assented to 29th March, 1989]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment  
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance (Variation of Short title  
Appropriation) (1988) Act, 1989.

Construction of Act No. 1 of 1988

2. In this Act and in any other written law, a reference to the Appropriation Act, 1988, shall be construed as a reference to that Act as for the time being varied or otherwise amended by any Finance (Variation of Appropriation) Act, passed before this or that other written law.

Increase in Heads of Expenditure

3. The sums appropriated to the several Heads of Expenditure set out in the first column of Part I of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1988, are hereby increased by the amounts specified in the second column of that Part.

New Head of Expenditure

4. The amount specified in the second column of Part II of the Schedule opposite to the Head of Expenditure specified in the first column of that Part is hereby appropriated in respect of that Head of Expenditure for the year ending 31st December, 1988.

Reduction in Heads of Expenditure

5. The sums appropriated to the several Heads of Expenditure set out in the first column of Part III of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1988, are hereby reduced by the amounts specified in the second column of that Part.

Sums appropriated in respect of Heads in Part II may be utilised Chap. 69:01

6. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Act, the sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in the first column of Part III of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1988, and unissued at the commencement of this Act, may be utilised for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase in the expenditure in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in Part I of the Schedule or by reason of the expenditure in respect of the Head of Expenditure set out in Part II of the Schedule.
