Act No. 21 of 1989

AN ACT for the incorporation of The Triune Shouters
Baptists and for matters incidental thereto.

[Assented to 13th June, 1989]

WHEREAS there has been established for many years Preamble
an organisation known as "The Triune Shouters Baptists";

And whereas it is expedient that the Triune be incorporated for the purpose of exercising the powers hereinafter set forth.

- Enactment** ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:—
- Short title** 1. This Act may be cited as The Triune Shouters Baptists (Incorporation) Act, 1989.
- Incorporation** 2. The Triune Shouters Baptists Organisation (hereinafter called “the Triune”) is hereby created a body corporate.
- Aims and objects** 3. The aims and objects of the Triune are:
- (a) to disseminate, teach and spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ;
 - (b) to preserve and perpetuate the principles and practices of the Shouters faith in Trinidad and Tobago and elsewhere;
 - (c) to foster and promote religious, educational and cultural activities in Trinidad and Tobago;
 - (d) to conduct evangelical work throughout Trinidad and Tobago and elsewhere;
 - (e) to ordain and license members of the Triune to practise as Ministers, Elders or Deacons;
 - (f) to co-operate with national and international agencies and organisations for the promotion of the Shouters faith;
 - (g) to procure radio and television time and to broadcast the Gospel of Jesus Christ;
 - (h) to accept collections, offerings, donations, bequests and any other form of contribution, to borrow or raise money for the promotion of the Shouters faith on such terms and on such security as may be thought fit and to hold and disburse such funds;
 - (i) to do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.

4. The Triune shall have power to—

- (a) acquire by purchase, transfer, donation, exchange, demise, bequest, grant, gift, conveyance or howsoever otherwise, any real or personal property or any estate or interest therein;
- (b) accept, surrenders or reconveyances and to enter into contracts;
- (c) sell, exchange, demise, mortgage or otherwise dispose of and deal with all property which may for the time being be vested in it, subject to any restraint, reservation or condition contained in the document under which it has acquired title.

5. All real or personal property of whatever nature now held by or vested in any person for the use and benefit of the Triune is hereby transferred to and vested in the Triune.

6. The Triune shall make rules and regulations as may be necessary for the proper conduct of its proceedings and for the discharge of its powers, duties and functions with power to vary or revoke such rules and regulations.

7. All documents requiring the seal of the Triune shall be sealed with the common seal of the Triune in the presence of the President and Secretary for the time being in office, or in the event of incapacity by some other person or persons authorised for that purpose by the Triune who shall both sign every such document and such signing shall be *prima facie* evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and that it is the lawful seal of the Triune.

8. (1) The Triune shall at all times have a fixed address in Trinidad and Tobago for the service of documents on it and that address and any change thereof shall be registered with the Registrar General within twenty-eight days of the date of incorporation or the change of address as the case may be.

Service of
documents

(2) Every document to be served on the Triune may be served by leaving the same at or by sending the same by registered post to the registered address of the Triune.

(3) Failure to register the address and any change thereof is a summary offence and renders the Triune liable to a fine of one hundred and twenty dollars and to a further fine of ten dollars for each day during which the offence continues after conviction therefor.

Saving of State
or other rights

9. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of the State or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any person, except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them.
