ON BEHALF OF BHP BILLITON (TRINIDAD-2C) LIMITED

NOTICE is hereby given that BHP Billiton (Trinidad-2C) Limited is desirous of executing a new project for the development of infrastructure to facilitate the production of oil and gas from the offshore Greater Angostura Field in Block 2(c), which includes the construction of an onshore pipeline, oil storage terminal, oil export pipeline and offshore tanker loading point and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 ("the Act").

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority ("the Authority") has, for the purpose of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority's reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Mondays to Fridays from 11th November, 2002 to 20th December, 2002:
