AN ACT to amend the Trade Ordinance, 1958.

[Assented to 20th March, 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellency Majesty by Enactment
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Trade (Amendment) Short title
Act, 1972.

2. The Trade Ordinance is amended—

(a) in section 4,

(i) by substituting for paragraph (b) there-
of the following:—

“(b) eight persons of integrity,
whether public officers or not,
who are competent to contri-
bute to the working and func-
tion of the Commission.”;

(ii) by repealing paragraph (c) thereof;

(b) in section 4A by deleting the words “other than
a public officer in respect of his office”, occur-
ring in lines two and three thereof.
