NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AN  
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT  
SUBMITTED BY THE ATLANTIC LNG COMPANY OF  
TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND  
OPERATION OF A CROSS COUNTRY NATURAL GAS  
PIPELINE FROM BEACHFIELD TO POINT FORTIN

NOTICE is hereby given that the Atlantic LNG Company of Trinidad and Tobago is desirous of executing a new project involving the establishment and operation of a cross country natural gas pipeline from Beachfield in Guayaguayare to the LNG facilities in Point Fortin and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001 thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purpose of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record and includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Mondays to Fridays from 18th November, 2002 to 27th December, 2002:
