Act No. 21 of 2004

AN ACT to provide for the Service of Trinidad and Tobago
for the financial year ending on the 30th day of
September, 2005.

[Assented to 28th October, 2004]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, Short title
2005.

Issue from the
Consolidated Fund
authorized

2. (1) The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of twenty thousand, seven hundred and sixty-nine million, four hundred and twenty-seven thousand, five hundred and ninety-four dollars (\$20,769,427,594) is hereby authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of the financial year ending on the 30th day of September, 2005 under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule hereto.

Schedule

(2) The sum specified in the Schedule opposite to each Head of Expenditure is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of twenty thousand, seven hundred and sixty-nine million, four hundred and twenty-seven thousand, five hundred and ninety-four dollars (\$20,769,427,594) for the purpose specified in relation to that Head in the Estimates of Expenditure for the said financial year.

Commencement

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 2004.
