Enactment	ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:—
Short title	1. This Act may be cited as the Finance (Supplementation and Variation of Appropriation) Act, 2005.
Further issue of \$3,050,211,864 from the Consolidated Fund Schedule I	2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund in the sum of three thousand, and fifty million, two hundred and eleven thousand, eight hundred and sixty-four dollars is authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of the financial year ending September 30, 2005 and appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in Part I of the Schedule to this Act.
Increase in Heads of Expenditure Act No. 21 of 2005	3. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act, 2005 are increased by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.
Reduction in Heads of Expenditure	4. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act, 2005 are reduced by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.
Sums appropriated in respect of Heads specified in Part II may be utilized Chap. 69:01	5. The sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act, 2005 and not utilized at the commencement of this Act may be utilized, notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Act, for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase in the Expenditure in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule to this Act.
