REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 2 of 1998

[L.S.]

AN ACT to provide for the Service of Trinidad and Tobago for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1998.

[Assented to 2nd January, 1998]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as ^{Enactment} follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the ^{Short title} Appropriation Act, 1998.

Issue of

from Consolidated
Fund authorised

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of eleven thousand, two hundred and eighty-seven million, two hundred and ninety-eight thousand and seventy-six dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1998 under the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite to a Head is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of eleven thousand, two hundred and eighty-seven million, two hundred and ninety-eight thousand, and seventy-six dollars for the purpose specified in relation to that Head in the Estimates for the said year.

Commencement

3. This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1998.
