TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 11 of 1966

[L.S.]

AN ACT to make special provision for the payment of superannuation benefit to certain employees of Government or of Statutory Authorities thereof.

[Assented to 28th June, 1966]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty Enactment by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Specified Officers (Super- Short title annuation) Act, 1966.

2. Notwithstanding any law in force at the commencement of this Act, but subject to this Act, it shall be lawful to grant to any officer named in the Schedule (herein referred to as a "specified officer") an annual allowance by way of superannuation benefit in respect of his service under the Government or any statutory authority thereof during the period commencing with the date stated in the Schedule as his date of appointment to the public service and ending with the date of his retirement therefrom.

3. (1) A specified officer who is granted an allowance under section 2 shall, if he has exercised his option, as herein provided, be paid in lieu of such allowance a capital sum and a reduced annual allowance as superannuation benefit.

(2) The option referred to in subsection (1) shall be exercisable in respects as if it were an option exercisable in respect of a gratuity and reduced pension payable under the Pensions Ordinance.

4. The provisions of the Pensions Ordinance and the Regulations made thereunder in so far as they relate to the grant, computation and payment of a pension or a gratuity and reduced pension to a public officer in respect of service in a pensionable office apply *mutatis mutandis* to the grant, computation and payment of an annual allowance, or of a capital sum and a reduced annual allowance, to a specified officer by way of superannuation benefit in respect of his service under the Government or any statutory authority thereof as if that service were service in a pensionable office; except that—

- (a) the length of service rendered by a specified officer after he has attained the age of sixty years shall not be taken into account in computing the annual allowance, but
- (b) in respect of service rendered after that age, a capital sum computed in accordance with regulation 12A of the Pensions Regulations as if it were a compassionate gratuity, may be granted.

5. All sums granted by way of allowances and otherwise under this Act are hereby charged on the Consolidated Fund.
