Act No. 27 of 1966

AN ACT for the Incorporation of The Sisters of the
Sorrowful Mother

[Assented to 23rd August, 1966]

WHEREAS the Order of the Sisters of the Sorrowful Mother, ^{Preamble} Inc., an Order of Nursing Sisters established and incorporated in the State of Wisconsin in the United States of America have appointed Barbara Stadlmann known in Religion as Sr. Mary Eulalia, Maria Eichinger known in Religion as Sr. Mary Alphonsa and Bernice Lopez known in Religion as Sr. Mary Lourdes to represent the said Order

and as Trustees to hold property for any of the uses and purposes of the said Order in Trinidad and Tobago.

And whereas it is expedient that the said Trustees and the Trustees for the time being of the said Order in Trinidad and Tobago should be incorporated under the name of the Sisters of the Sorrowful Mother for the purpose of exercising the powers hereinafter set forth.

Enactment

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title

1. This act may be cited as the Sisters of the Sorrowful Mother (Incorporation) Act, 1966.

Incorporation of the Order

2. The said Barbara Stadlmann known in Religion as Sr. Mary Eulalia, Maria Eichinger known in Religion as Sr. Mary Alphonsa and Bernice Lopez known in Religion as Sr. Mary Lourdes and their successors in office as such Trustees as aforesaid shall be and are hereby created a body corporate by the name of "The Sisters of the Sorrowful Mother" and by that name shall have perpetual succession, and may sue and be sued in all courts of Justice in Trinidad and Tobago by that name, and shall have and use a common seal with power from time to time to change such seal.

Powers of the Corporation

3. The corporate body hereby created shall have power
- (a) to acquire by purchase, transfer, donation, exchange, devise, bequest, grant, gift, conveyance or however otherwise, any real or personal property or any estate or interest therein;
 - (b) to accept surrenders or re-conveyances and to enter into contracts;
 - (c) subject to any restraint, reservation or condition contained in the document under which it shall have acquired title thereto, to sell, exchange, demise, mortgage, or otherwise dispose of and deal with all property which may for the time being be vested in or have been acquired by it.

Mode of Execution of Documents

4. All documents requiring the seal of the corporate body shall be sealed with its common seal in the presence

of two of the Trustees of the corporate body for the time being in office who shall both sign every such document, and such signing shall be *prima facie* evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and that the same is the lawful seal of the corporate body.

5. The corporate body shall at all times have a fixed address in Trinidad and Tobago for the service of documents on the corporate body and such address shall be registered with the Registrar General. All documents to be served on the corporate body may be served by leaving the same at, or by sending the same by registered post to, the address so registered.

6. All lands and other property of what nature so ever now vested in the said Barbara Stadlmann known in Religion as Sr. Mary Eulalia, Maria Eichinger known in Religion as Sr. Mary Alphonsa and Bernice Lopez known in Religion as Sr. Mary Lourdes shall be and the same are hereby transferred to and vested in the body corporate hereby created.

Vesting of
property in
the Corporation

7. Nothing in this Act shall affect the rights of Her Majesty, Her Heirs or Successors or any bodies politic or corporate or of any other persons except such as are mentioned in this Act and those claiming by, from or under them.
