TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 10 of 1964

[L.S.]

AN ACT to exempt the University College of the West Indies from certain stamp duties, and to apply certain exemptions enjoyed by the University College to the University of the West Indies.

[Assented to 25th April, 1964.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the University Exemption Short title Act, 1964.

Interpretation

2. In this Act—

“the College” means the University College of the West Indies;

Ordinance No. 34 of 1960

“Ordinance” means the University College Exemption Ordinance, 1960, and includes any enactment amended by that Ordinance;

“the University” means the University of the West Indies.

Instrument conveying property of I.C.T.A. to U.C.W.I. exempt from stamp duty

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Ordinance, the instrument by which property of the Imperial College of Tropical Agriculture was conveyed to the College (which instrument was registered in the Protocol of Deeds for the year 1962, kept by the Registrar General as No. 6758 of 1962) is, and shall be deemed always to have been exempt from stamp duty; and any stamp duty or penalty paid under the Stamp Duty Ordinance in respect of that instrument shall be repaid to the University out of moneys provided by Parliament.
