LIMITED

NOTICE is hereby given that British Gas Trinidad and Tobago Limited is desirous of executing a new project involving the establishment of two offshore natural gas wells in Block 5(A), laying of pipelines and Dolphin A platform modifications and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purpose of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Mondays to Fridays from 24th February, 2003 to 4th April, 2003:

- (e) Couva/Tabaquite/Talparo Regional Corporation, Railway Road, Couva.

And take notice that the comments of the public are hereby invited on the application for the Certificate and the Environmental Impact Assessment and that a person wishing to submit comments must do so in writing addressed to the Corporate Secretary, Environmental Management Authority, 8, Elizabeth Street, St. Clair, Port-of-Spain from Monday, 24th February, 2003 to Friday, 4th April, 2003.
