FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A JETTY WITH  
ASSOCIATED WORKS, GALEOTA

NOTICE is hereby given that Snubbing Services Limited is desirous of executing a new project at Galeota Point for the creation of an approach channel, the establishment of a turning basin, construction of a new jetty and associated reclamation works and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purpose of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Mondays to Fridays from 4th August, 2003 to 12th September, 2003:

And take notice that the comments of the public are hereby invited on the Environmental Impact Assessment and that any person wishing to submit comments must do so in writing addressed to the Corporate Secretary, Environmental Management Authority, 8, Elizabeth Street, St. Clair, Port-of-Spain from Monday 4th August, 2003 to Friday 12th September, 2003.
