NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT OF AN
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT
PREPARED BY COASTAL DYNAMICS ON BEHALF OF
BPTT LLC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO INVOLVING THE
DEVELOPMENT OF INFRASTRUCTURE TO FACILITATE
THE PRODUCTION OF OIL AND GAS

NOTICE is hereby given that BPTT LLC is desirous of executing a new project for the development of infrastructure to facilitate the production of oil and gas from the Offshore South-East Galeota Block (SEC) in the Cannonball Field. This includes an offshore component comprising the construction of a Wellhead Protector Platform and Pipeline to the existing Cassia B Hub and onshore upgrade of the Beachfield Gas Receiving Facility and construction of a pipeline which will tie into NGC's Cross Island Pipeline and this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance ("the Certificate") pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 ("the Act").

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority ("the Authority") has, for the purpose of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority's reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Mondays to Fridays from 16th February, 2004 to 26th March, 2004:
