CORPORATION LIMITED (TNBCL)

NOTICE is hereby given that Tobago Nationwide Broiler Corporation is desirous of executing a new project involving the Establishing of Poultry Processing and Offal Dehydration Plant at Roxborough Estate, Tobago and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purpose of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Mondays to Fridays from 13th April, 2004 to 21st May, 2004:

(d) Roxborough Branch Library, 24A, Bloody Bay Road, Roxborough, Tobago;

(e) Charlotte Branch Library, Corner Church and New Streets, Charlotteville, Tobago.

And take notice that the comments of the public are hereby invited on the Environmental Impact Assessment and that any person wishing to submit comments must do so in writing addressed to the Corporate Secretary, Environmental Management Authority, 8, Elizabeth Street, St. Clair, Port-of-Spain.
