ON BEHALF OF LOS BAJOS OIL LIMITED (FORMERLY
WELL SERVICES ENERGY LIMITED)

NOTICE is hereby given that Los Bajos Oil Limited (formerly Well Services Energy Limited) is desirous of executing a new project involving the drilling of one hundred and twenty exploratory wells in the South Quarry Farmout Block (SQFB) located in south Trinidad and this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purpose of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday from 5th July, 2004 to 13th August, 2004:
