NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT OF AN  
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT  
SUBMITTED BY PETROTRIN TRINMAR OPERATIONS

NOTICE is hereby given that the Petroleum Company of Trinidad and Tobago Limited, Trinmar Operations (TRINMAR), is desirous of executing a new project involving the establishment of twenty-one development wells and their associated facilities at north and south-west Soldado Fields and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purpose of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Mondays to Fridays from 28th July, 2004 to 7th September, 2004:

- (a) the Environmental Management Authority, 8, Elizabeth Street, St. Clair, Port-of-Spain;
- (b) the Department of Natural Resources and the Environment, No. 78 Wilson Road, Units 6 and 7, High Moore Centre, Scarborough, Tobago;

- (c) the San Fernando City Corporation, City Hall, Harris Promenade, San Fernando;
- (d) the Point Fortin Borough Corporation, George Road, Point Fortin; and
- (e) the Arima Borough Corporation, 8, Hollis Avenue, Arima.

And take notice that the comments of the public are hereby invited on the Environmental Impact Assessment Report and that any person wishing to submit comments must do so in writing from Wednesday 28th July, 2004 to Tuesday 7th September, 2004 addressed to the Corporate Secretary, Environmental Management Authority, 8, Elizabeth Street, St. Clair, Port-of-Spain.
