NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT OF AN  
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT  
SUBMITTED BY LEASE OPERATORS LIMITED

NOTICE is hereby given that Lease Operators Limited (LOL) is desirous of executing a new project involving the establishment of eleven development wells and their associated facilities at Fyzabad Oil Fields (Block WS-11) and this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purpose of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday from Monday 29th November, 2004 to Friday 7th January, 2005:
