NOTICE is hereby given that Damus Oil Limited is desirous of executing a new project involving the drilling of twenty-nine Infill and Replacement Wells and conduct of associated works in Coora Blocks 1 and 2, located in the south/central part of southern Trinidad and this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purpose of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Mondays to Fridays, from Thursday 13th January, 2005 to Friday 18th February, 2005:
