SUBMITTED BY PETROLEUM COMPANY OF TRINIDAD  
AND TOBAGO LIMITED TRINMAR OPERATIONS  
(TRINMAR)

NOTICE is hereby given that Petroleum Company of Trinidad and Tobago Limited (Petrotrin) is desirous of executing a new project involving the establishment of thirty-three development wells and their associated facilities in the Barrackpore area of the Penal, Barrackpore and Wilson Field and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purpose of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday, from 28th November, 2005 to 6th January, 2006:

- (e) Penal-Debe Regional Corporation, Dookie Street, Penal.

And take notice that the comments of the public are hereby invited on the Environmental Impact Assessment Report and that any person wishing to submit comments must do so in writing from 28th November, 2005 to 6th December, 2006 addressed to the Corporate Secretary, Environmental Management Authority, 8, Elizabeth Street, St. Clair, Port-of-Spain.
