THE DRAINAGE DIVISION OF THE MINISTRY OF WORKS
AND TRANSPORT

NOTICE is hereby given that the Drainage Division of the Ministry of Works and Transport is desirous of executing a new project involving the proposed drainage and flood control scheme involving the establishment of the Mamoral Dam and associated works at Mamoral and this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purposes of the certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday, from Monday 26th June, 2006 to Friday 28th July, 2006:

- (c) Chaguanas Borough Corporation, Corner Taitt and Cumberbatch Streets, Chaguanas;

- (e) Department of Natural Resources and the Environment, No. 78 Wilson Road, Units 6 and 7, High Moore Centre, Scarborough, Tobago.

And take notice that the comments of the public are hereby invited on the Environmental Impact Assessment Report and that any person wishing to submit comments must do so in writing addressed to the Corporate Secretary, Environmental Management Authority, 8, Elizabeth Street, St. Clair, Port-of-Spain from Monday 26th June, 2006 to Friday 28th July, 2006
