NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AN
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT
SUBMITTED BY BP TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO, LLC (BPTT)
FOR THE MANGO FIELD (SOUTH-EAST GALEOTA BLOCK)
DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

NOTICE is hereby given that BP TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO, LLC (BPTT) is desirous of executing a new project involving the development of the Mango Field (South-East Galeota Block). The proposed project involves the establishment of a 9 slot Well Protector Platform (WPP), the drilling of six (6) development wells and the installation of a seven (7) kilometre long, twenty-six (26) inch diameter subsea multiphase pipeline connecting the WPP to the existing twenty-six (26) inch pipeline between Cannonball and Cassia B, and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purposes of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday, from Monday 23rd October, 2006 to Friday 24th November, 2006:
