ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT
SUBMITTED BY ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES LIMITED ON
BEHALF OF BP TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO LLC (BPTT)

NOTICE is hereby given that BP TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO LLC (BPTT) is desirous of executing a new project involving the proposed installation of a 9-slot Well Protector Platform (WPP), a twenty-six inch diameter subsea multiphase pipeline and the drilling of seven (7) Development Wells from (WPP) within the Cashima and the North East Queen Beach (NEQB) Fields located approximately 75km offshore from the southeast coast of Trinidad and this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purposes of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, and copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday, from Monday 23rd October, 2006 to Friday 24th November, 2006:
