TRANSPORT—HIGHWAYS DIVISION, PROJECT
IMPLEMENTATION UNIT

NOTICE is hereby given that the Ministry of Works and Transport—Highways Division, Project Implementation Unit is desirous of executing a project to construct a highway from San Fernando to Princes Town. The project would involve the clearing of land and other associated works to facilitate the construction of this highway, which is approximately 11 kilometres in length and that this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purpose of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday, from Monday 15th January, 2007 to Friday 2nd March, 2007:

And take notice that the comments of the public are hereby invited on the Environmental Impact Assessment Report and that any person wishing to submit comments must do in writing addressed to the Corporate Secretary, Environmental Management Authority, 8, Elizabeth Street, St. Clair, Port-of-Spain, from Monday 15th January, 2007 to Friday 2nd March, 2007.
