NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AN
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT
SUBMITTED BY CSA INTERNATIONAL INC. ON BEHALF
OF PETRO-CANADA TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO BLOCK 22
INC.

NOTICE is hereby given that Petro-Canada Trinidad and Tobago Block 22 Inc. is desirous of executing a new project involving the proposed drilling of Fourteen Exploratory Wells in Block 22 off the north coast of Tobago. The total area within which the intended activity may occur is 296,829 ha. The proposed exploration wells are expected to be drilled to an anticipated depth of 2200 m. This project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance (“the Certificate”) pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 (“the Act”).

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority (“the Authority”) has, for the purposes of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority’s reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday from Monday, April 16, 2007 to Friday, May 18, 2007:
