NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON AN
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT
SUBMITTED BY BG TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO LIMITED

NOTICE is hereby given that BG Trinidad and Tobago Limited is desirous of executing a new project involving the drilling of six (6) development wells, installation of a single unmanned platform, and construction of a 19.8 kilometre long, twenty-inch (20") multiphase gas and condensate pipeline in the Poinsettia Field, within the North Coast Marine Area (NCMA), north of Trinidad and this project is deemed a designated activity pursuant to the Certificate of Environmental Clearance (Designated Activities) Order, 2001, thus requiring a Certificate of Environmental Clearance ("the Certificate") pursuant to section 35 of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 ("the Act").

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority ("the Authority") has, for the purposes of the Certificate and pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an Administrative Record that includes a written description of the proposed action, the major environmental issues involved in the matter under consideration, copies of relevant documents or other supporting materials which the Authority believes would assist the public in developing a reasonable understanding of those issues and a statement of the Authority's reasons for the proposed action.

And take notice that the Administrative Record is available to the public for viewing at the following offices from 8.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday from Monday 30th April, 2007 to Friday 1st June, 2007:
